DFJ VINHOS HIGHLIGHTS

- Created in 1998 only to export to the UK.
- Mr. José Neiva Correia is the owner and chief winemaker producing wines since the harvest of 1974.
- **❖** Control of 400 ha of single estates mainly in Lisboa wine region.
- "Good agriculture" creating the best grapes respecting the environment.
- 22 Portuguese and Internacional grape wine varieties.
- Average anual production of 500000 cartons of 9 liters.
- Installed storage capacity of 9,3 million liters.
- Vinification in 2 wineries producing up to 6 million liters
- Today we export 98,5% to 54 countries with a team of 35 people.

JOSÉ NEIVA CORREIA and DFJ VINHOS

ROOTS / TRADITION

Mr. Neiva born and raised in 1949 in the single estate vineyard Quinta de Porto Franco (60 km north Lisbon, 20 west Atlantic) in its family since the 17th century, with 80 ha producing some of the DFJ best wines in its own vinification center.

RESPECTING THE ENVIRONMENT

Mr. Neiva apply healthy agricultural practices in the 200 ha of his family vineyards where the vines are fed with organic material. The nutrition of the vines is done in a rational way without excesses or deficiencies. The vine's needs dictate the dosage of water and nutrients conceded.

SCIENTIST / INOVATION


Always searching and testing, new methods, new varieties and unique blends, Mr. Neiva also developed and patented the first method for disinfecting the corks using ozone sold onto Grupo Amorim. This has helped worldwide in reducing the level of undesirable TCA a great threat to wine making.

PRICE/ QUALITY / CONSUMER ORIENTED

To create wines that people like to drink, made in Portugal, with a good relation price/quality it's the key objective.




DFJ headquarters are located in the **Quinta de Fonte Bela** (one hour driving to the north of Lisbon). A centuries-old single estate, almost all the buildings respect the "Cast-iron Arquitecture" of the late XIX century, designed by Eiffel's engineers. Named in the region the **Wine Cathedral** host a vinification center, bottling line, warehouse, wine cellar with 9,3 million liter capacity, barrel cellar, cooperage facilities, laboratory and guests room. it's the house of more than 20 couples of storks and its babies each year from October to June.
